 - a. Addition of update of the New Fernbank E.S. from Principal, Todd Thompson with the Principal's Report

- 3. Treasurer Report (Marit)
 - a. Food Day sales \$2623.85 to date
 - b. Mabel's Labels \$62.25 cheque received
 - c. Lorenzo's fundraisers: \$160.10
 - d. Pro Grant cheque received \$500 (for parent involvement)
 - e. Funds available of \$6053.20
 - f. From Jaime:
 - i. With Food Days and some other fundraisers now allowed, we will be able to do some more fundraising this year and start next year with some money and hopefully return to our very healthy School Council budget in 2022-2023. We encourage the divisions to take a look at the money they still have in their budgets and start some spending! The primary team still has a lot of money and the Juniors have their division budget as well as their Scholastic budget.
 - ii. Many classes still have their workshop money. This may now be used to lower the cost of a field trip. Each class has \$244. We received the following note from Scientists in Schools: "Our virtual program is quite similar in many ways to our in-person workshops students are still provided materials for experiential learning related to that topic and they still engage with the presenter by sharing their thoughts and answering/asking questions. Each student receives their own mini bag of materials that allows them to fully engage in the topic! They get very excited to open up their bag of goodies AND they get to keep everything to continue exploring after the workshop. Our presenters ,who join the class virtually, are still quite effective at engaging with the students by discussing their observations and results."
 - iii. Kirsten Woodward and Jaime are going to look at doing a Green Team initiative in the front garden with the funds available.
 - iv. There is still some literacy (\$1700), numeracy (\$2500) and science

(\$1500) money for the school.

- 4. OCASC Report (Dwayne/Kevin/Arron)
 - a. Minutes can be found on the OCASC website.
 - b. PIC trying to arrange more Pro-Grant guest speaker series
- 5. Principal's Report (Rob)
 - a. Changes since March Break Bit of shock for everyone with changes, but gradual return to more normalcy at school is occurring.
 - b. Most students and staff are still wearing masks indoors.
 - c. Case of 5th's disease reported
 - d. Zones for recess being eliminated. Down to just two now: Primary and Junior
 - e. These changes are strange for Grade 1 and 2's they have never experienced school without Covid restrictions.
 - f. Staffing shortages coverage of all staff is still a daily challenge.
 - g. Healthy kinder enrollment for next year reported
 - h. New Fernbank school may impact numbers and staffing, but not as much as predicted (so far at least)
 - i. Class placement requests for next year have been sent out to parents.
 - j. School Climate Survey upcoming Ministry Survey for 4-6th grade students
 - k. EQAO is back almost entirely online. Window for completion: May 4-18.
 - I. Few new chromebooks and the last one from the most recent remote learning period has been returned. In good standing on the tech front!
 - m. Principal of New Fernbank ES, Todd Thompson, joined for a brief update:
 - i. Planning is well underway for the opening of Fernbank Elementary school that is scheduled for September 2022. Extensive planning and preparation is underway to ensure as smooth a transition as possible for students and families.
